



Hello There.

Welcome, weary journeywoman. You've found this Planner, which has been carefully crafted just for you. We hope it can serve you and your family well for the next year of language learning adventures you are sure to have.

This Planner is ideal for families trying to become bilingual and especially geared toward families with children ages 3-8. It is easily adapted for under age 3 by dropping the longer activities. Learning as a family exposes parents to the cultural expectations their children will face in their new language environment and provides children with the stress-relieving presence of their parents, enabling them to retain more and experience the joy of learning. Following this Planner is not meant to make you fluent, but rather a fun and fruitful way to create bilingual habits in your home.

This Planner is built from the best methods and thinking we've found. Total Physical Response lesson activities are based on the Natural Language Learning Method, and we sandwich those between "scripts" which particularly pertain to children and building relationships. Our educational philosophy echoes Charlotte Mason, who recommended giving children the best that any culture has to offer in music and story and allowing children to enjoy these things without having to prove they are learning.

In addition to helping you speak a new language, this curriculum is designed to help your family discover the culture. Unfamiliar cultures are brimming with hidden assumptions about how one should behave. These activities are designed to help you uncover some of these nuances, so your children can behave confidently within that culture.

Three authors have helped to create this planner with over 30 years of combined experience living overseas with children. We have all found our niche in helping other families on their bilingual journeys. Along that process, we wrote this planner for ourselves and a wonderful woman inspired us to share it.

We believe children should feel welcome in any language. On that note, we dedicate this curriculum to the man who once said, "Let the little children come to me, do not hinder them, for the Kingdom of God belongs to such as these."

How to Use This Planner

- 1. Find a Language Mama (Native Speaker) who is available to meet with you and your children a minimum of 1.5 hours each week. An ideal Language Mama is not someone with teaching experience, but a person who will follow your direction well, young enough to be able to enjoy playing with your children and won't shame them. Think of what you would look for in a babysitter. As for payment, a similar amount to the local babysitter rate works well. Let them know you will be present and guiding them for that hour. We have found that women make some of the best native speakers for drawing out a child's participation and making them feel comfortable. If your children are already friends with a man who speaks the language, using a "Language Papa" would be fine. In these instructions, we will stick with the assumption that the native speaker is a woman.
- 2. Commit to 1-4 hours to lay out the whole year in one planning session, filling out all the "Choose Your 12 ____" planning sheets. This will save you much decision-making later on. The time needed greatly depends on what resources you already have at your fingertips, such as toys and picture books. We know finding songs in other languages can be challenging, and we recommend searching on YouTube for children's songs to save time.
- **3.** Commit to 15 minutes once at the beginning of your week to completely fill out that week's Lesson plan (One sheet per week, titled Lesson A, B or Review).
- 4. Commit to 10 minutes a day of activities with your children. Use the checkboxes provided in every Lesson plan. These daily activities can be video based but it is preferred to have a Language Mama come to your house daily that is preferred.
- 5. Conduct a 1.5 hour class once a week (may include 10 minute prep time before class for snacks and gathering materials).
- 6. Commit to audio or video recording of the Language Mama lesson sessions to review during your daily times. The learning approach of this Planner is only functional if the learners are exposed to a native speaker's voice daily.

Lesson Building Blocks

What's inside each lesson? Here's a short description of each activity type. Some of these are optional, but all of them have a reason to be here. There is something for every child's learning style.

Story The best story to use is one where the pictures help the child care about the story. Seeing vivid pictures give a clear context to discover meaning. The story can be any picture book where Language Mama retells the story in the new language.	Song Every culture sings to their children learning songs helps the child remember words and have fun. The song should be from the Language Mama's culture. A song with simple words and hand movements is ideal. A translated song also works.
Courtesy Script All cultures have rules of how to interact politely and what is rude. When children do not know these rules, they often get shamed. This activity is a chance to discover what is the proper way to interact.	Family Script Languages usually have different ways of speaking within the family or home. This activity is a chance to learn mundane, familial scripts that families often use to make them part of your family's home life.
Play Children play in every culture. This activity is for learning the names of those games in Language Mama's culture, including the rules of play, associated phrases and how to join in other children's games.	Show & Tell This is an activity set aside to visually learn what different things in Language Mama's culture look like. What does a bedroom look like, what does a breakfast look like, or how do you pray? All of these things vary greatly from one culture to the next.
TPR: Nouns Four nouns are chosen from both the story and song contexts in each lesson and made into a Total Physical Response game. Pictures or physical items to represent these words are found online or our website. TPR sessions for this planner are listed on the website too. Languagelearningforchildren.com	TPR: Verbs One verb is chosen from both the story and song contexts in each lesson and made into a Total Physical Response game. The verbs are covered in different tenses and conjugations in the TPR sessions listed on the website. Languagelearningforchildren.com
Review Games Children easily forget words they don't recall frequently. Review games combine the vocabulary (verbs and nouns) from the lesson of the previous two weeks into a fun game. These are listed on the website. Languagelearningforchildren.com	Add Ons: Snack: Not essential, but oh-so enjoyable for the children. Snack time also teaches essential request and gratitude phrases in a fun context. Toy Reveal: Children love seeing special toys come out and learning how to interact with them in another language. Language Mama will show some toys one at a time, and then children will play freely. Clean Up: A very practical way to start learning to work and take directional commands in the new language.

Lesson Structure How-To

PLAN YOUR YEAR:

Before you get right into making Lessons, take a 1-3 hour planning session to make the rest of your 36-week year a breeze. During this planning session, read the lists of 12 recommended examples for each activity category, and then take time to fill in the "Choose your 12" planning pages provided. Twelve items fit into the three weeks per lesson, 36-weeks per year design of this planner.

To build each three-week lesson, you will be taking one item from each category and filling it into the planner's structure. This allows you to customize each lesson set completely to your family's interests or needs.

DAILY LESSONS: 4 days per week, 10 minutes a day. The daily lessons can be done the 4 days prior to the weekly lesson if you already have videos. This is ideal for children who are language-resistant, as they get to familiarize themselves with the bulk of the lesson's content before the class. If you do not have videos to use, you will have to take videos during the weekly lesson and use those videos for your daily lessons the following week. Pick one video to show to your children for each day of the weekl.

Story: Watch a video of a story being read by a native speaker.

Song: Watch a video of a song being sung by a native speaker.

Courtesy Script: Watch a video of puppets doing a short script.

Family Script: Watch a video of puppets doing the script you are starting to use in your house daily.

Coloring Time: Let your children color in a coloring book from the culture they are learning or let them color in one of our coloring pages while listening to the audio of those items.

WEEKLY CLASS FOR LESSON A AND B:

Courtesy Script: Language Mama uses puppets to do your chosen courtesy script, performing it twice before handing the puppets to the children, who each get a turn doing the puppet's mouth motions as the Language Mama does the voices for all the puppets. The goal is to hear the courtesy script as many times as the children are still interested. (5 minutes)

Song: Language Mama sings the song showing the hand motions if there are some and the children listen and sing along, too. (5 minutes)

Song Total Physical Response (TPR): 4 nouns and 1 verb are chosen in advance from the song and are used in a Total Physical Response session to discover the meaning of these words. To learn how to run a Total Physical Response session please go to our website: languagelearningforchildren.com (10 minutes nouns, 5 minutes verbs)

Snack: Try to introduce an interesting snack from Language Mama's culture. Language Mama tells children what the snack is, then asks if they want some. She models the proper response, and children can respond and get their snack. This is a great motivator for young children and the repeated phrases "Want more? Say please!" will benefit children in nearly any context. (5 minutes)

Story: Language Mama "reads" a picture book to the children either by translation if the book is in English or by simply describing the pictures and discovering the story herself if she cannot read English. If the children point to parts of the picture she can interrupt the story to say what those things are. The session ends with "Where is the?" Questions and the children can respond by pointing at the pictures. (5 minutes)

Story Total Physical Response (TPR): 4 nouns and 1 verb are chosen in advance from the story and are used in a Total Physical Response session to discover the meaning of these words. To learn how to run a Total Physical Response session please go to our website: languagelearningforchildren.com (10 minutes noun, 5 minutes verb)

Family Script: Language Mama uses puppets to perform a short script you have chosen to integrate into your daily bilingual routine. Then the mother (you) and the child act out the script as they say it. Skip this part for children under age 3. If you have older children and under age 3 children, you can do the Toy Reveal first and let the smallest ones play with the toys while you do the Family Script with the older children. (5 minutes puppet, 5 minutes acting it out)

Toy Reveal: Have a set bag or basket of toys that are reserved exclusively for use in language class and have the Language Mama say and reveal the toys one at a time: "Here's a ball. Who wants to play with it?". Then let the children play freely while you do any recordings you did not get during the lessons for the following week's review. (5 minutes revealing the toys, 10 minutes of free play)

Clean Up: If the Language Mama knows a Cleaning Up song, singing it at the end of each class is great. If not, she can just start cleaning up toys and instruct the children: "Now gather the blocks. Good job! Who will put this car away? All done." Encourage the children clean up with the Language Mama and then say goodbye and thank you. (5 minutes)

REVIEW LESSON:

Courtesy Script: You may do any of the Courtesy scripts from previous lessons for review. (5 minutes puppet, 5 minutes acting it out)

Show and Tell: This unique session allows the Language Mama to show and tell you and the children about some new cultural aspect. Perhaps what a time of day in their culture is like or a certain activity or place. For more info, see the 12 Show & Tell Ideas page and Choose Your Show & Tell Ideas page. She explains in her language, using pictures in order for sequencing the meaning to be discovered. Then the Language Mama shows you both the "right" way (or typical) to do the chosen activity and the "wrong" way (or atypical). (10 minutes)

Snack: Same as Lesson A and B. (5 minutes)

Play Script: Children play in every culture and have games with rules, names and ways of joining in. This time is intended to help your children learn those things, so they might join in someday with local children of the new culture. Language Mama explains how to play and names some of the items used in the "Play". There are usually associated phrases consistent with each game. Example: "Go fish! You're it!" (10-15 minutes)

Review Game: Combine the words learned in Lesson A and B Song and Story into a review game. There are some listed on our website, languagelearningforchildren.com. You may need to make images of these vocabulary words or use the ones available on the website. (One game, 10 minutes)

Family Script: Same as Lesson A and B (5 minutes puppet, 5 minutes acting it out)

Toy Reveal: Same as Lesson A and B (5 minutes of toy revealing, 10 minutes of playing)

Clean Up: Same as Lesson A and B (5 minutes)


12 Stories

We picked these stories because they are some of the most widely available picture books in the world. Even though these books need to have the Language Mama translate them, we preferred them because their pictures created such a clear context for discovering the meaning of the words and still telling a story. Using local picture books can be a good way to build vocabulary if the local picture books have a story element. Picture books that are just images randomly put together do help to build vocabulary, but do not give the child a chance to build the skill of discovering the meaning of words and tracking story progression.

Songs in this section need to have a simple tune, an interesting subject/story element or a great way to add in new words through the fill in the blank nature of the song. Language Mama might offer to sing a song from movies, TV or pop-culture, but these songs often do not carry the cultural information or simple words needed for children. Try asking your Language Mama, "What songs did your mother sing to you as a child?" Or have her ask elderly relative if they remember their mother ever singing to them and what songs they learned. Tracking down a few songs will be worth it, linguistically and culturally.

12 Courtesy Scripts

The Courtesy Scripts are examples from American culture. These will not be the same phrases in other cultures, they may not even be verbal. In Argentina, kissing on the cheek is part of greeting and taking one's leave. This is something Argentine people even make babies do. In Muslim cultures, there is a blessing or "giving peace" in the greeting script. In India it is rude to ask an elder their name. These are kinds of things you need to include and practice with your children.

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12 Types of Play/Games

The types of play listed here are the most common and basic forms of play children around the world share. We also chose these types because of the ease of items or space involved. The goal of this part of lesson is to help the child see that there are interesting things to play in this new culture as well.

Try to pick games or play that you know your children enjoy and that fit with your setting. If you have difficulty with finding local games you can fill this with free time playing where the Language Mama just does imaginary play with you and your child using the child's toys. For under age 3 this is an ideal way to create bonding.

12 Show & Tell Ideas

The goal during the show and tell time is to visually see cultural differences. Have the Language Mama clearly act out the right and wrong way to do something so you can see the cultural assumptions behind that activity. Or have the Language Mama help you find pictures of the scenes or cultural items that you are discussing so you can see what they look like without having to have the Language Mama prepare to bring all those items (Example: Breakfast foods.)

Choose your 12 Show & Tell Ideas

Choose things that you know your child would enjoy seeing visually. Example: Construction vehicles, holiday celebrations, or types of party clothing. This the time to enjoy the beauty and the fascinating differences that can be found in the new culture as well as finding out the "right" way or "common" way to do that in the culture and the "wrong" way or "uncommon." This time usually involves lots of giggling and rowdy behavior which is fine, since the children being exposed to these cultural elements is more important than being keeping the class calm.
